



Edge Water Music Therapy
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Information for Case Workers and Community Providers

Music therapy is the clinical and evidence-based use of music interventions and experiences, provided by a board certified music therapist, for the purpose of addressing non-music therapeutic goals and objectives. Music therapy can be used to support clients in a number of different treatment domains both independently or in collaboration with a treatment team.

Music therapists often work in cooperation with other health professionals, families, treatment teams, and schools to assist in the development and achievement of goals and objectives.

When working with Edge Water Music Therapy, the following can be expected:

Intake and Assessment	Quarterly Review of Progress
